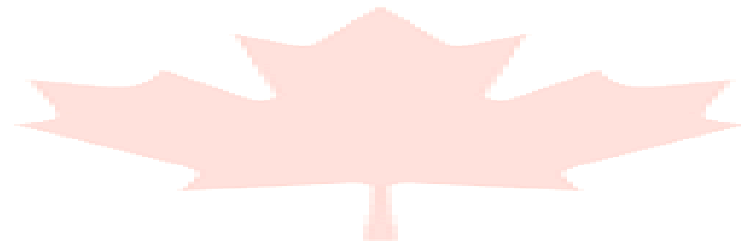

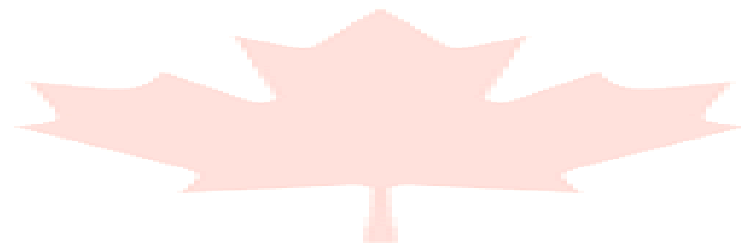
6.1 *“In fulfilling its obligations under this Convention each State Party has the right to seek and receive assistance.”*
